

## **PRAC 2016 Show Rules**



1. Entrants must provide their own clear container (with the required one flat side & a cover which can be removed for judging) and water for each entry in show.
2. Anyone is eligible to enter any number of fish/shrimp. No entry may be entered in more than one class. You need not be a member of an Aquarium club.
3. \$2.00 per entry (except \$2.50 for non-members of IBC/BBC for Betta classes only).
4. Registration opens 8:00am & all fish/shrimp registered by 9:45am. All entries must be benched & ready by 10:30 a.m. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 9:45am & THE SHOW ROOM WILL BE CLOSED AT 10:30am FOR JUDGING**
5. All entries will be under the jurisdiction of the show chairperson until tear down (approx. 4:30pm.) and may not be removed from the show until conclusion of the auction, unless authorized by the show chairperson.
6. Fish/shrimp which display any disease or deformity may be disqualified.
7. The show will be judged by C.A.O.A.C. certified judges and/or apprentice judges.
8. Their decisions will be final and not subject to appeal at the show. If in their opinion the entries in a class do not come up to show standards, a non-contest may be called. If there are only two entries that are satisfactory then any combination of 1st, 2nd and 3rd may be awarded.
9. In any case of dispute the show chairperson's decision will be final and binding.
10. No poop, snails, ornaments, sand, plants or stones etc. may be present in a tank.
11. It is the responsibility of the entrants to make sure their fish/shrimp are in the correct class. The show chairperson will help upon request.
12. No aerosol sprays or mist type cleaners will be permitted in the show area.
13. All accessories & equipment (i.e. pails, nets, etc.) must be kept out of sight.
14. All show fish/shrimp to be auctioned after the show must be labelled as such by the owner and registered prior to the auction & show. It is also the responsibility of the owner to bag the fish/shrimp for auction, after the awards presentation has taken place.
15. No moving other peoples show tanks without the approval of the chairperson first.
16. Provisions will be made for the well being of fish/shrimp; however Peel Regional Aquarium Club is not responsible for loss or damage sustained during the show.
17. Prizes are a Ribbon for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each of the Classes and also a Ribbon for 'Best of Show' for each Category.
